Q1:

What can we understand from the statement above? (1 point)

- D) A true friend never makes mistakes.

CONCLUSIONS

Q1: A true friend will always support you, no matter what.

The statement emphasizes that true friendship is about loyalty and support in all situations, not just during happy times. The wrong answers focus on partial or incorrect understandings of friendship.

What can we understand from the statement above? (2 point)

- A) Plants are harmful to humans and animals.
- B) Plants help maintain the air we breathe.
- C) Humans and animals do not need plants to survive.
- D) Carbon dioxide is the only gas in the air.

CONCLUSIONS

Q2: Plants help maintain the air we breathe.

The statement explains the process of photosynthesis, where plants take in carbon dioxide and produce oxygen. This shows their importance in keeping the air clean and breathable. The wrong options either misunderstand or ignore the key role of plants.

SOLUTION IS B

Q3: “Making a fair decision means considering different opinions before choosing what is right for everyone.”

What can we understand from the statement above? (3 point)

- A) Fair decisions are made without listening to others.
- B) Everyone should agree on the same idea.
- C) Fairness requires thinking about multiple perspectives.
- D) The best decision is always what one person wants.

CONCLUSIONS

Q3: Fairness requires thinking about multiple perspectives.

The statement highlights that fairness means listening to different viewpoints before deciding. The wrong answers suggest unfair or one-sided decision-making, which goes against the meaning of fairness.

SOLUTION IS C

Q4:



Comedy movies are popular because they make people laugh and feel happy. They often use funny situations, jokes, and silly characters to entertain the audience. Some comedy films are based on everyday life, while others create exaggerated or unrealistic scenarios to make people laugh. Many comedy movies also include important messages about friendship, family, or life lessons. No matter the type, comedy films help people relax and enjoy their time.

Why might some comedy movies include messages about friendship or family? (4 point)

- A) To make the movie more emotional and meaningful.
- B) Because all comedy movies are based on real-life events.
- C) To make people feel sad instead of laughing.
- D) Because comedy movies are only for children

CONCLUSIONS

Q4: To make the movie more emotional and meaningful.

The paragraph mentions that comedy movies sometimes include important messages. This suggests that filmmakers want to add meaning beyond just making people laugh. The incorrect answers either make false claims or contradict the paragraph's message.

- A) They always tell true stories about real people.
- B) They focus on making people laugh rather than creating fear or suspense.
- C) They do not include any lessons or deeper meanings.
- D) They use complicated plots and serious dialogue to entertain the audience

CONCLUSIONS

Q5: They focus on making people laugh rather than creating fear or suspense.

The paragraph describes comedy movies as being entertaining and humorous. Unlike horror or suspense films, which aim to scare or create tension, comedy movies focus on laughter. The incorrect answers either contradict the paragraph or describe unrelated genres.

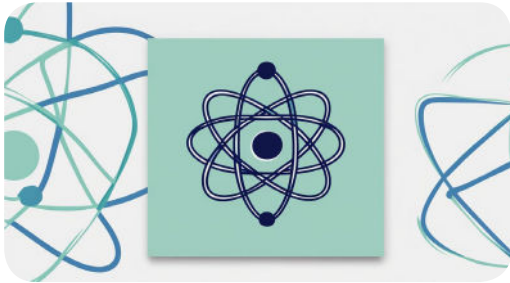
Q6: The Many Ways Comedy Movies Entertain Us

The paragraph discusses different elements of comedy films, including humor, exaggeration, and deeper messages. The other titles are either too specific (C, D) or suggest a comparison that the paragraph does not make (B).

SOLUTION IS A

Read the paragraph and identify the disruptive sentence. (7)

Q7:



Atoms are the basic building blocks of all matter. They are made up of three main particles: protons, neutrons, and electrons. Protons and neutrons are found in the nucleus, while electrons move around the nucleus in energy levels. Atoms of the same element always have the same number of protons. Some atoms are so large that they can be seen with the naked eye. Different elements have different numbers of protons, which determines their chemical properties.

Which sentence should be removed to make the paragraph well-structured? (7 point)

- A) "They are made up of three main particles: protons, neutrons, and electrons."
- B) "Protons and neutrons are found in the nucleus, while electrons move around the nucleus in energy levels."
- C) "Some atoms are so large that they can be seen with the naked eye."
- D) "Different elements have different numbers of protons, which determines their chemical properties."

CONCLUSIONS

Q7: "Some atoms are so large that they can be seen with the naked eye."

The paragraph describes the structure of atoms and their fundamental properties. However, the statement that "some atoms are so large that they can be seen with the naked eye" is incorrect and contradicts scientific knowledge, disrupting the logical flow of the paragraph. Atoms are too small to be seen without powerful microscopes. The other sentences correctly explain atomic structure and properties.
